These newly designed lightweight range of Walk It Out trailers from O'Phee feature a lightweight moving floor system, with special aluminium extruded plank sides that allow for smooth flowing and extra strength.

With lightweight steel construction, it is a safe and easy way to discharge bulk products. Ideal for signwriting, the unit is easy to clean and can hold a standard 95 cubic metres of product – although this can be adjusted to suit individual needs. According to O'Phee Trailers, moving

floors are a better option for unloading hard-to-tip bulk product, or low-density, high cubic bulk freight.

On their Walk It Out trailers, O'Phee's have combined aluminium and steel to come up with a result that they say is, in some cases, fractionally lighter than an

all aluminium moving floor, but with the strength of a steel main frame and at a significant cost saving.

The design also avoids the usual reaction that is caused when steel and aluminium rub together and allows for easy replacement of the aluminium sidewall planks when worn, for hassle free, easy to maintain performance.

Using Cargo Floor on their drive units, O'Phee say the system is easy to fit, featuring a 21-plank floor. Fewer planks equals less moving parts, which means less wear.

O'Phee Trailers have been involved in the manufacture and sale of semi trailers for more than 40 years and is owned and

operated by Mick and Sharon O'Phee. The company is built on the values of superior performance, reliability and customer service.

Predominantly involved in the manufacture and sale of purpose-built semi trailers, the company invests heavily in tooling and technology to ensure its manufacturing techniques are as up to date as possible.

Historically, the majority of O'Phee trailers built, have been purpose-made with intricate design specifications, but O'Phee's are still capable of high volume standard type builds.
